



## **Larry Clayton**

Author, retired University of Alabama history professor



Larry Clayton taught at the University of Alabama for more than 40 years. Now professor emeritus of history, he has published a dozen history books and one novel. He also has his own blog and writes a weekly opinion column for The Tuscaloosa News.

Clayton grew up in Lima, Peru, with his Chilean mother and American father. After graduating from Duke University, he served in the Navy on the U.S.S. Donner (LSD 20) for two years in the Caribbean and Mediterranean, then went to New Orleans

and graduate school at Tulane. He began teaching at Alabama in 1972 and retired in 2013.

His most recent book was a biography of a Dominican priest, Bartolomé de las Casas (1485-1566). Two books are forthcoming in 2015: Work and Wealth in Scripture (Eugene, Oregon: Wipf & Stock, 2015) and Bartolomé de las Casas in Documents (New York: Bedford St. Martins, 2015).

He has two grown daughters, a son flying Lear jets in an international jet ambulance service and his wife, Louise, is a pastor.

### This Week in History

On Feb. 9, 1971, Mobile native Leroy "Satchel" Paige becomes the first Negro League veteran nominated to the Baseball Hall of Fame; world chess champion Gary Kasparov loses a game to Deep Blue, an IBM computer, on Feb. 10, 1996, but would go on to win the six-game match; Nelson Mandela, leader of the movement to end apartheid in South Africa, is released from prison on Feb. 11, 1990, after serving 27 years; Galileo Galilei arrives in Rome on Feb. 13, 1633, to face charges of heresy for advocating Copernican theory; Valentine, a holy priest in Rome, is executed on Feb. 14 around the year 278 A.D.

## Last Week — February 3, 2015

University of Alabama President Judy Bonner updated the club on progress at the Capstone. She said that accepting a higher number of out-of-state students as UA has been doing in recent years is required of any university to become a nationally competitive institution. As of the fall semester 2014, UA had 36,155 students enrolled. UA also enrolls more Alabama residents than any two- or four-year college or university in the state, including 18,591 Alabama residents during the 2013-14 school year. For fall 2015, 34,000 students have applied for a seat in the UA freshman class. This year alone, UA had one Truman Scholar, two Goldwater scholars, five Hollings scholars, and eight Fulbright scholars enrolled. UA has also increased degree production by 50 percent over the last five years. Among the construction projects completed or under way on the University of Alabama campus over the last few years are the Annette and Richard Shelby Engineering and Science Quad, Presidential Village, Fresh Food Dining, seven new Greek houses, the Ferguson Center expansion, the Digital Media Center housed in Bryant-Denny Stadium and the
