

Rick Bragg is a best-selling author, Pulitzer Prize-winning journalist, University of Alabama writing professor and noted storyteller.

Bragg, a Piedmont native, was a reporter and national correspondent for The New York Times, where he won the 1996 Pulitzer Prize for feature writing. He has written a half-dozen books, including his bestselling memoirs, "All Over But the Shoutin" and "Ava's Man," and has won more than 50 writing awards, including two American

Society of Newspaper Editors' Distinguished Writing Awards. He also has worked for the Anniston Star, Los Angeles Times and the St. Petersburg Times, and taught writing at Harvard and other universities.

Bragg credits his writing ability to the oral storytelling of family and friends during his childhood in the Appalachian foothills of Alabama.

He now teaches writing in the journalism department at UA and writes a column for Southern Living magazine. His latest book, a biography of Jerry Lee Lewis (HarperCollins), is scheduled for release on Oct. 28.
