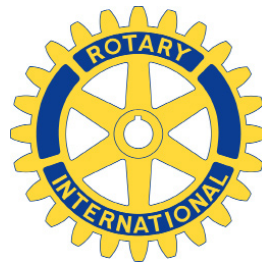

Last Week — June 21, 2016

State Rep. Bill Poole, chairman of the House Ways and Means Education Committee, spoke to the club about the recent legislative session and the political turmoil in Montgomery following the recent conviction of House Speaker Mike Hubbard, the issues surrounding Gov. Bentley and suspended Alabama Chief Justice Roy Moore and whether Bentley will call a special session of the Legislature. Poole, who represents District 63, which includes much of the city of Tuscaloosa, said he hopes that the Republican and Democratic caucuses will be able to convene in Montgomery soon to determine a process on how to go about selecting a speaker to replace Hubbard.
